

Royal Society Te Apārangī Diversity Stocktake

In its diversity policy, put in place in 2016, the Society committed to publishing data for the year ended 30 June 2017. This first report contains data for core Society activities, but not for those activities undertaken on contract for other organisations. We currently do not have ethnicity data for all groups so we have noted Māori membership where we have it, but not in all instances. We also do not have full gender data, only male or female. This will be collected in future. Except for staff (who have been consulted directly), the data presented have been derived from Society records and databases and not specifically authenticated with individuals. These issues will be addressed in future data collection, and will include gender and ethnicity queries in line with Department of Statistics standards for the Census.

The Academy

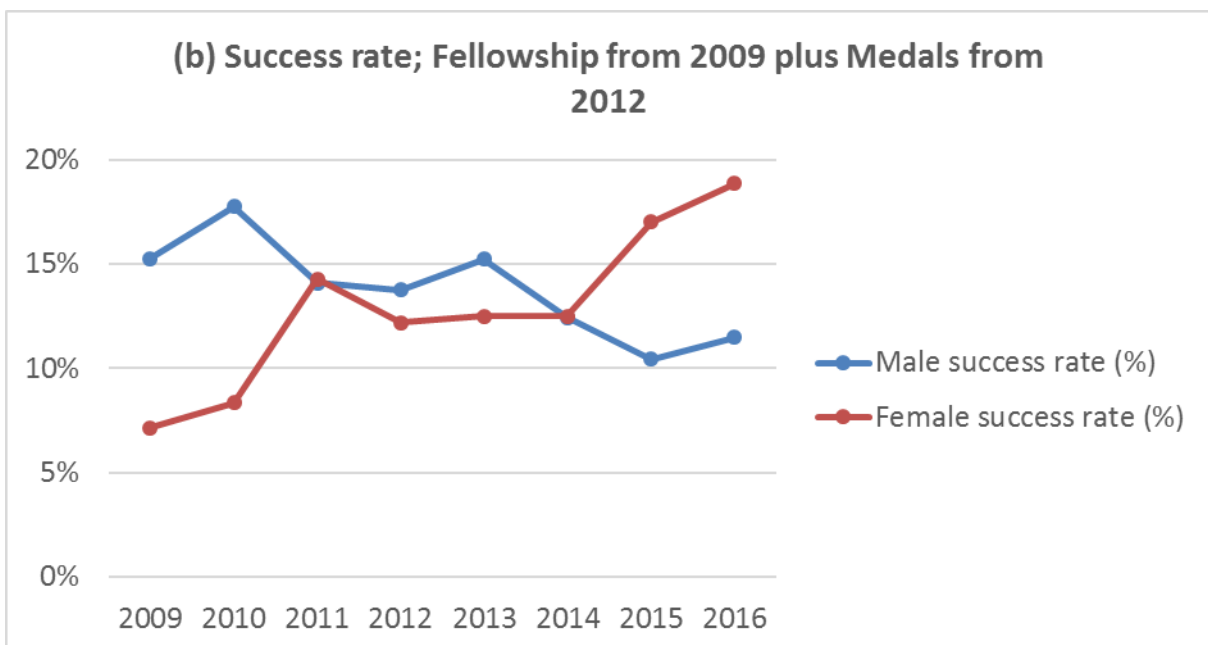
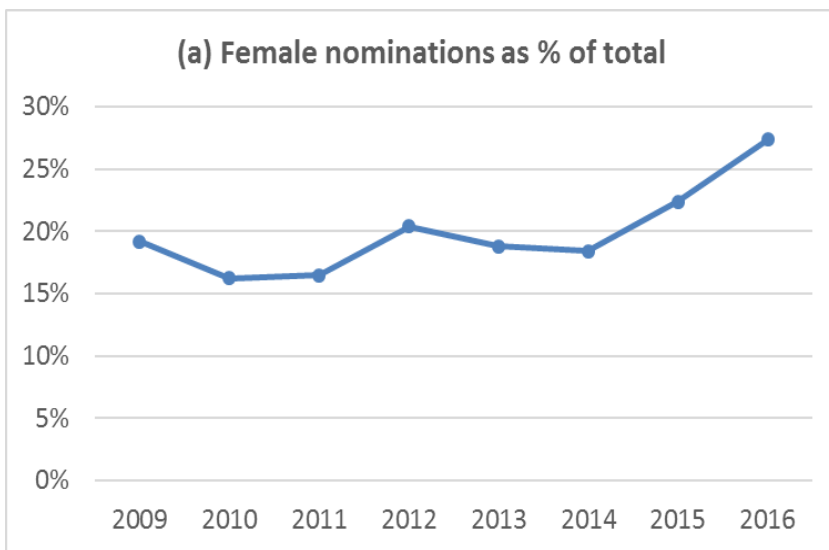
The Academy is governed by the Academy Executive Committee. That Committee requires that Fellows undertake a number of selection roles on panels and committees. In 2016 the Society set a starting target that 30% of nominations and panel/committee members should come from under-represented groups. Public Talks

The Society selects experts to give public talks, or to participate in panel presentations and discussions; and the winners of particular medals or awards are required to do a series of talks. As some speakers repeat their presentations in more than one location the data are shown in two ways – as a straight count of speakers, and secondly, as the number of speaker appearances.
