

Summary of responses to New Zealand ORCID consortium members' survey, March 2017

Background

A short email survey was sent to all Consortium members on the 7th March, and responses requested by the 22nd March. The purpose of this survey was to provide information to inform the advisory committee of activity and intention towards ORCID within their sectors. By the 23rd March, 25 of 41 Consortium Members had responded, and a summary of these responses is presented below. A table of the individual responses can be found as Table 3.

Question 1: Does your organisation have a current integration with ORCID?

Of the 25 survey respondents, 17 had no current integration. Those who had integrations were predominantly universities whose integrations were with a CRIS (Symplectic Elements) and the University of Auckland's 'myORCID' service.

Question 2: What ORCID integration plans does your organisation have for the next twelve months?

There were 15 respondents with no plans for integration in the next 12 months. Those with plans to integrate were mainly from the university and the central government sectors, plus 1 ITP and 1 IRANZ member.

Question 3: Is your organisation intending to use the ORCID hub?

The majority of respondents indicated their intention to use the hub. Of those who had no plans to use it or were unsure, three indicated that this was because their organisation had the technical capability to use the ORCID API directly. Six respondents were unsure or indicated that they would possibly use the hub.
